

CANDIDATE DEVICE

Candidates must log into the device when directed. Candidates will have the device during orientation and throughout the exam. Please review the tutorial for specific instructions on using the platform.



Be mindful of the power button on the device. Candidates must never power down the device during the exam.



Candidates will have access to the following on their device during orientation time: evaluations, candidate guide, and site information and equipment list. Please note that 7 minutes before the exam is scheduled to start, the candidate's device will no longer be able to access this information.

Candidates will have access to the orientation video and tutorial during orientation but \underline{not} on the candidate device.

During the exam, the candidate will be able to use their device to:

- View station overview information
- View patient encounter clinical data
- Order and review ancillary tests
- Complete assessment and plans
- Monitor break, observation/overview, and exam cycle time



PATIENT ENCOUNTER (PE) STATIONS DOCKING STATION

Each PE Station includes a docking station. A docking station provides access to a desktop monitor, keyboard and mouse. The desktop monitor can be used as a larger screen to view images.

Use of the docking station is optional.







If a candidate wishes to use the docking station, candidates will need to connect the device to the docking station. When connecting to the docking station, ensure the cable is fully pushed into the port as displayed in the image to the left. If you have difficulty connecting, inform the SP or the hallway monitor.

When connected to the docking station, candidates may use a keyboard/mouse and their laptop screen will be mirrored onto a desktop monitor.

PATIENT ENCOUNTER (PE) STATIONS NOTE BOARD

Candidates may take notes in the PE rooms during observation time and throughout the exam cycle using a note board.

Note boards must remain in the exam room.

The note board uses a stylus to write. Slide the stylus to the left to use.



Lock and Unlock

The note board will be in the locked position when the candidate enters the room. The locked position will prevent the candidate from accidentally clearing their notes. If a candidate wishes to clear their notes, they must unlock it. The unlocking toggle switch is on the back of the device.





Clear

To clear out all data on the board, unlock the board and press the button on the right.

Once cleared, the previous information can not be restored.

SKILLS STATIONS LIGHTING


MAIN OVERHEAD LIGHT SWITCH, DIMMER LIGHT SWITCH, AND SLIDER

Located to the left of counter area Location of this switch is the same in EVERY exam room

Main overhead light switch is located on the LEFT Dimmer light switch is located on the RIGHT Slider to adjust dimmer brightness is on the RIGHT side of the dimmer switch



Because there are two main overhead light switches in the exam room, candidates may need to place the switch in the up or down position to adjust the overhead lights.



UNDER-CABINET LIGHT SWITCH

Located above the sink counter, by soap dispenser

Exam Chair Overview Reliance 6200-L Chair













Exam Chair Overview Reliance 6200-L Chair

To recline the exam chair:

Pull DOWN on the lever located on the back of the chair Lower the chair and position appropriately Release the lever while lowered to lock the chair in place









To rotate the chair, push the silver handle towards the floor. When the chair is in position, pull handle to the original position to lock in place.


SKILLS STATIONS SLIT LAMP OVERVIEW

Slit Lamp

Haag-Streit 900 BI Slit Lamp Video System For optimal views, candidates <u>must</u> use focus rod to focus the oculars

Bright White:

Top pin fixed all the way to the left, cannot be moved








Power:

blinking green = **standby** solid green = **on**

Non-functioning buttons







Blue Filter

Circular dial turned all the way to the left so "B" is displayed



Yellow Filter

If the lever is at , the filter is IN

If the lever is at , the filter is OUT

(the filter cannot be in between these positions)



Tray

- Tray will contain ready to use, alreadydisinfected, gonio lens and tonometer probe
- Please keep tray closed until the start of the exam
- After using the instruments, please place on a clean paper towel


Large Volk 4-Mirror Glass Gonio Fundus Lens with Flange

POSTERIOR SEGMENT SKILLS STATION BIO

Keeler BIO Vantage Plus Slimline Wireless Plus Indirect System



- The BIO headset will be hanging on the stand
- Without an appropriate target <u>and</u> working distance (18-25 inches) the target will appear decentered
- The BIO has been equipped with our camera system to ensure captured views

FIXED

- aperture
- filter
- brightness
- circle beam height
- +2.00 oculars

ADJUSTABLE

- fit behind head
- fit on top of head
- PD
- Pantoscopic tilt: angle of ocular to eyes

Knob loosens to adjust ocular distance to eyes Illumination will be set by the SP Slide to adjust PD between 48-76 Vertical fit Turn to tighten or loosen fit
